### Frequently Asked Questions

#### **Who is eligible?**

Applicants must be in and/or serving Lincoln, Illinois. Applicants must be designated as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and have been determined to not be a "private foundation" under Section 509(a) of the code. Occasionally, we may also make investments in applicants that have federal tax exemption under other designations, such as public schools and government entities.

#### **When can I apply?**

Integrity Data will accept applications from now through 5 p.m. on Friday, March 29, 2019.

#### **What is the deadline?**

5 p.m. on Friday, March 29, 2019

#### **Who is selecting the recipient(s)?**

The Integrity Data team will review and vote on the received applications.

#### **When will the recipient(s) be notified?**

Applicants will receive notification of award status by 5 p.m. Wednesday, April 17, 2019.

Applicants receiving grants will be invited to a dessert reception at the Integrity Data offices on Thursday, April 25, 2019 to receive their grant and meet the Integrity Data team.
