Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible?

Applicants must be in and/or serving Lincoln, Illinois, or any community where one of our remote employees is located. Applicants must be designated as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and have been determined to not be a “private foundation” under Section 509(a) of the code. Occasionally, we may also make grants to applicants that have federal tax exemption under other designations, such as public schools and government entities.

When can I apply?

Integrity Data will accept applications from now through 5 p.m. on Monday, November 15, 2021.

What is the deadline?

5 p.m. on Monday, November 15, 2021.

How are recipients selected?

All applications are reviewed and ranked by all team members based on the compelling story and impact of the grant.

When will the recipient(s) be notified?

Applicants will receive notification of award status by 5 p.m. December 3, 2021. Those selected will receive their checks by mail in December.
